OPEN SKOKIE ROAD
 IN MONTH, BELIEF

Expected That Regular Service
 On New Line Will Start
 About April 15

Regular service will be started on the new Skokie valley line of the Chicago North Shore and Milwaukee railroad on April 15 according to present plans of the company as announced by B. W. Arnold, assistant general manager, at the start of work on the new station at Mundelein, yesterday.

The announcement was received with some surprise as it was generally believed that the line would not be ready for operation before May 1 or later.

Advancement of the date of the opening of the line indicates that the company has speeded up the work of construction with the intention of placing the line in operation as soon as possible.

With the completion of the new line the North Shore will place a series of fast limited trains in service between Chicago and Milwaukee which will attain speed schedules that will exceed those in force on any other electric line in the nation.

The new line will also open up a new territory, which will eventually become one of the finest residential sections in the middle west, it is believed.

ELA TOWNSHIP TO
 IMPROVE ITS ROADS

Bond Issue Proposition To Be
 Submitted To Voters For
 That Purpose

Ela township of Lake county, with the thriving community of Lake Zurich as its center, plans to be all dressed up in well gravelled roads to welcome the tourist and homeseekers of the future. The realization of these plans depends on the vote of a bond issue of \$50,000 to be presented to the citizens in the township elections on April 6.

According to the plans of the highway commission of the township, passage of the issue at the polls will permit the improvement of more than 20 miles of country roads in that district.

Grading, draining and graveling of the highways selected for surfacing are provided for in the plans according to Fred Grimm, Ela township highway commissioner.

Residents of the township are in favor of this project, for the most part, it is stated and it is expected that the issue will be carried by a large majority vote.

At present it appears as though there will be two candidates in the Grant township race, Frank T. Stanton and George Keoth, Sr.

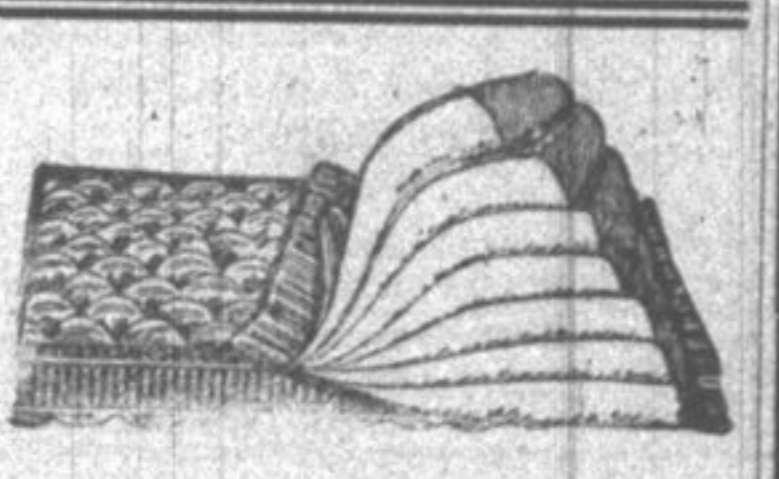
Three Republican candidates for state treasurer have withdrawn from the primary race. They are:


