Continued from page one to be erected in the future. The tower, when it is constructed, will be situated on the highest point of land in the city, and later may replace the present tower on the city hall property.

The report of Pearce, Greeley, and Hansen, with reference to the construction of the new incinerator plant, which is badly needed, was placed on file. Provision for construction will probably be made soon, and the new plant will cost in the neighborhood of \$7,500.

File Franchise Ordinance
The ordinance providing for a franchise for the new Skokie valley route of the North Shore Line was placed on file. It will probably be passed at the next meeting of the council, and will then be submitted to a referendum vote.

Favorable comment was voiced by several members of the council concerning the fair dealing of the railroad company in several matters. The North Shore Line, although it is not required to do so by law, has agreed to pay one-half of the special assessment for roads running parallel to and adjoining its right-of-way on the Skokie valley route.

DROPPED INSURANCE MAY BE REINSTATED

The State of Illinois sent 320,000 men into the military service during the World War. Virtually all of those men took out the War Risk Insurance while in the service but since their discharge over three-fourths not knowing the value of this insurance, have allowed it to lapse and today are in ignorance as to their rights to reinstatement and conversion of this insurance.

The insurance dropped amounts to more than two and one-half billion dollars. Under the supervision of Dr. Frank T. Duffy, regional manager of the U. S.
