

**NEW TEACHERS FOR DEERFIELD-SHIELDS**

Applications of two new teachers and the resignation of a faculty member were accepted at a meeting of the Deerfield-Shields board of education last Thursday evening, May 13. Mr. Blandford Jennings is the resigning teacher and Miss Zoe Comer and Mr. George Edward Haefner are the two new teachers.

Mr. Jennings has accepted the professorship of the teaching of English at the State Teachers' college in Kirksville, Missouri, where his work will be that of training teachers.

Mr. Haefner, who is to be Mr. Jennings' successor, was graduated from the University of Minnesota in 1920. He later studied at the Sargent school in New York. He has taught successfully in the Bay View high school of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, and in the Central high school in Duluth, Minnesota. During the past year he has been teaching at the Harvard School for Boys in Chicago and has been taking post-graduate work at the University of Chicago.

Miss Comer, who is to be the new dramatic and public speaking teacher, was also graduated from the University of Minnesota. She taught for two years in the Menominee, Wisconsin, high school where she was especially successful in teaching dramatics and public speaking. Later she entered the school of speech at Northwestern university in Evanston where she studied for two years. During her second year of study at Northwestern she held a position as teacher of dramatics on the faculty of the Boltwood junior high school in Evanston.
