PLANS NEW SYSTEM OF FREIGHT HAULING

North Shore Line Reported to Be Working Out Better Handling Plan


Reports that the Chicago North Shore and Milwaukee railroad is contemplating the adoption of a new system of freight hauling that will not only promote economy for the railroad but likewise service to its patrons, is arousing much interest in railroad circles. The scheme is projected if carried through is novel to an extreme and is regarded as a distinct departure in railroad projects.

It is understood that the railroad company is planning on placing a series of flat cars into service that will serve as carriers for special types of automobile trailers, which are likewise to be adopted by the company.

If the plan is carried the trailers can be loaded in various parts of the city and then conveyed by auto to terminal points where they will merely be loaded on cars and then hauled to the city to which they are consigned. After reaching there they are again taken from the cars attached to autos or tractors and then conveyed to industries or commercial houses where they will be unloaded. The scheme will be especially advantageous in the handling of carload lot shipments of freight it is declared.

The scheme would offset the necessity of the transferring of freight at terminals, offsetting possibilities of loss by damage on the mislaying of articles. It would guard against possible delays.

The plan is regarded as one that could be followed with success on all railroads and it is likely that if it is adopted by the North Shore that other lines will follow suit.


