SHERIDAN ROAD BRIDGE IS CLOSED

One of Two on That Highway Reported Unsafe; New Ones Probable

Because of its reported unsafe condition for passage of heavy traffic

the south bridge of the two on North Sheridan road, near the Moraine

has been closed, following inspection by an engineer, and traffic is

being routed over North St. Johns

avenue north to Fort Sheridan. The

present heavy rains are a contributory

cause to the unsafe condition of the

bridge, it is said. Both these bridges

are very old and their replacement

with two new and modern bridges is

contemplated.

A special election to be held in this

city on Aug. 14, on a proposition to

issue bonds amounting to \$238,000,

for the rebuilding of the two bridges,

will hasten the improvement, if the

bond issue plan is approved by the

voters, which is generally expected.

The remainder of the total sum to be

included in the bond issue will be

used to pay for the betterment

of the city, including the rebuilding

of the incinerator and for general

improvement purposes, including public

health payments.
