ILLINOIS HIGHWAYS FINEST IN COUNTRY

State Has Approximately 5,600 Miles of Paved Roads; Hazard Grows

Illinois has approximately 5,600 miles of paved highways. The construction of these roads was financed by the automobile owners of the state, who are paying in \$13,000,000 annually to meet interest charges and pay the principal on bond issues and for maintenance of the roads.

"Since 1917, when the plan for applying automobile fees to highway bond issues was worked out," Secretary of State Louis L. Emmerson says, "the state has lifted itself out of the mud. Instead of being one of the most backward states in road improvement as it was then, it is now recognized as one of the most advanced."

"When we first began discussing this legislation we were collecting only a little over a million dollars a year in automobile fees and there was grave doubt as to whether or not the fees would take care of the interest and principal of the proposed \$60,000,000 bond issue in the twenty years allowed."

"Since that time we have collected more than \$62,000,000 in fees and not only are paying the interest and amortizing the indebtedness on the original bond issue but have assumed a \$100,000,000 bond issue."

"The automobilists of Illinois, without question, are getting more for their money than are the owners of motor vehicles in most other states. Every cent of the fees goes directly into the highway fund."

Mr. Emmerson points out, however, that the excellence of the hard roads increases the hazard of driving because a few reckless drivers use them as speed ways.

"The great majority of automobile owners are law abiding citizens and are careful drivers," he said. "It is unfair that a few reckless drivers should be permitted to menace lives and property on the hard roads of the state. Recklessness can be curbed only by punishing the reckless and constituted authorities everywhere should see that this is done."

Electric railway companies of Illinois have an investment of more than \$80 for every person in the state.

NEW CHAIRMAN OF FARM LOAN BOARD

The appointment of Albert C. Williams as chairman of the Federal Farm Loan commission points to the adoption of a strong and progressive policy in the administration of the Federal Farm Loan system. Both the Federal Farm Loan and the Federal Intermediate Credit systems are of vital importance to American agriculture. Although the Federal Farm Loan system has been in operation less than ten years, the federal and joint stock land banks up to the present time have made loans of approximately \$2,000,000,000.

In the even shorter period of their existence the Federal Intermediate Credit banks have served agriculture in an effective way by making loans for agricultural purposes aggregating over \$300,000,000.

Mr. Williams brings to this position a first-hand knowledge of agriculture and a sympathetic interest in its needs. He has been closely associated with the livestock interests of the country, as an official of the Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers' association, as president of a livestock loan company, as a representative of the War Finance corporation in handling agricultural loans and in other ways. He is a firm believer in co-operative marketing and he has taken an active part in organizing co-operatives among livestock men.

GOOD BRAKES BEST ELEMENT OF SAFETY

Should Be Tested Daily, Expert Says; How to Keep Them in Good Condition

One of the greatest elements of safety is good brakes. Brakes should be tested daily by throwing out the clutch and applying them on a dry spot of street where there is little traffic. If the brakes are not operating properly the fault should be corrected at once.

Once in two months remove the rear wheels and wash the brake lining in kerosene. This removes all oil and the "bite" of the brakesetoin

grease which if present take the "bite" out of the brakes. Never oil brake lining.

Brakes squeal when they are glazed or when improperly adjusted. Squealing can often be stopped by removing wheels and roughening the brake lining with a stiff brush.

If the brake lining is worn down to the rivets, sink the rivets further or have the brakes relined.

Wipe off and oil the brake mechanism every 500 miles, or oftener.

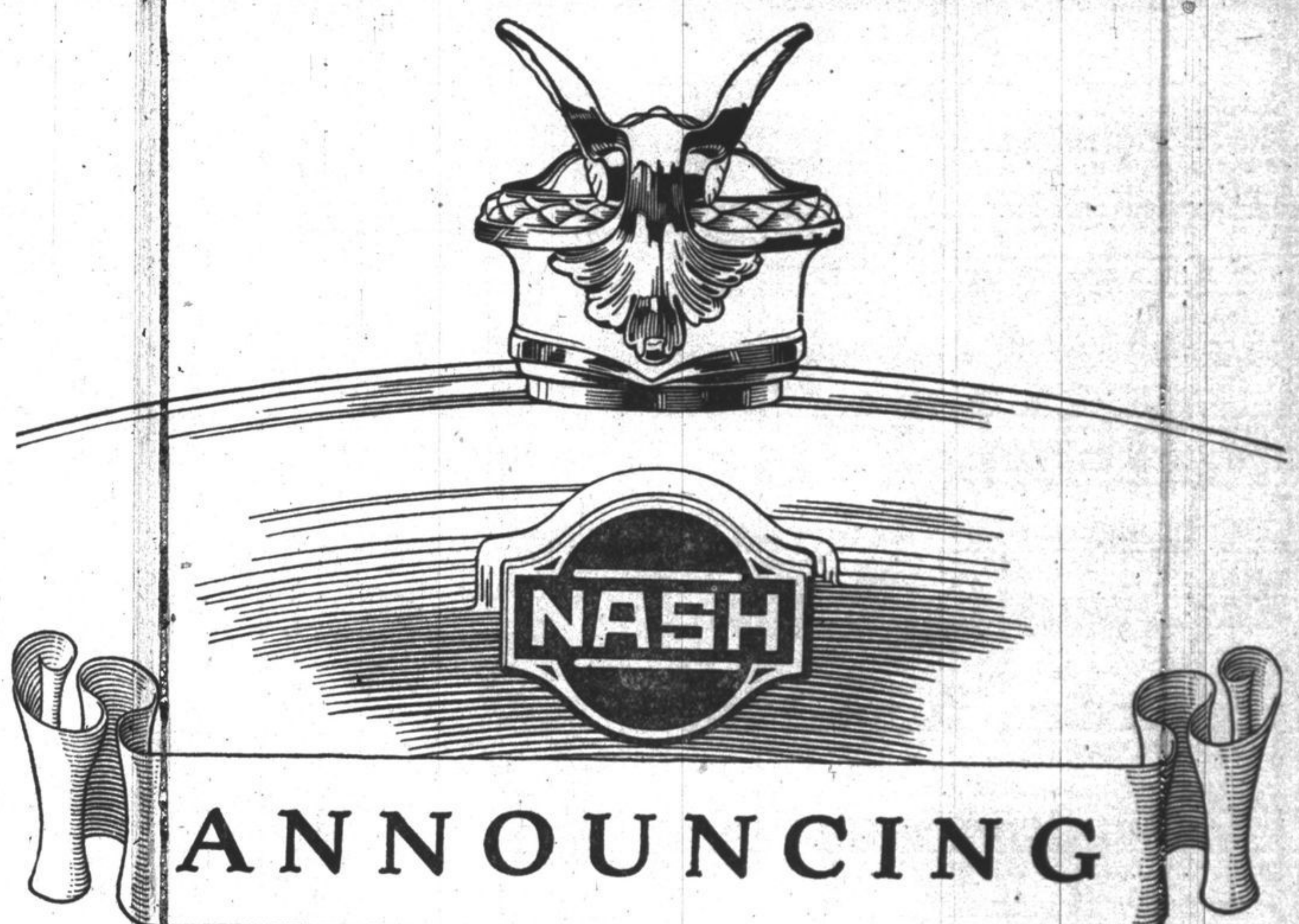
