In a similar manner, the old fashioned custom of getting the children's clothing in order at home has become obsolete. Mother need no longer stitch and mend, scrub and clean, for we take all this trying work off her hands. We will clean, repair, sew on all the missing buttons and do everything which is necessary to put them in order for school days.
