FOOTBALL GAMES AT GREAT LAKES OPEN

Public Invited to Attend Without Charge; Good Accommodation; Dates

Football is the sport at the Great Lakes Naval Training station upon which interest is now centering. A picked team has been organized and under the direction of Lieutenant Commander George S. Arvin, U. S. Navy, the Athletic Officer, and Coach C. H. McCann, is said to have developed surprisingly good form.

According to an announcement made today by Captain John F. Hines, U. S. Navy, the commandant at Great Lakes, the public is cordially invited to witness this and such future games as may be played at Great Lakes this season, and no charge will be made for admission.

Captain Hines also states that the grand stand and bleachers will afford ample and comfortable accommodations for all who may wish to attend the games, and that provision has been made for adequate parking space for automobiles near the Athletic field.

The game with the soldiers of Fort Sheridan, which will be played in the stadium on West Washington street in Waukegan, is looked upon as the big football event of the season heretofore, and the announcement of the arrangements for it is being awaited with much interest.
