NO DANGER OF OIL SHORTAGE IS SEEN

SUPPLY FOR 1,000 YEARS

Research Institute In Report Says Plenty for All Purposes; Reserve Lands Extensive

Reports that the supply of oil is rapidly becoming exhausted have been accepted with no small amount of credence by the public, unacquainted as they are with the true facts in the case. But to those closely in touch with the oil situation this publicity is recognized as coming either from a few alarmists who, although acting in good faith, give out erroneous information or from those directly interested in boosting some phase of the oil market. The oil shortage "scare" has been spread largely by "wild cat" companies and stock promoters, who in their publicity promise extravagant profits to "investors" holding stock in their companies when limited supply has sent oil prices soaring.

More Oil Produced

But statistics prove that instead of an oil shortage, more oil is today being produced than ever before in the history of the country—that production is considerably in excess of the demand—that oil producers have been placing vast quantities of oil in storage as a reserve for future use.

"The source of motor fuel is unlimited" says the American Research Foundation in a recent bulletin—"Men who ten years ago predicted dollar gasoline within a year have been thoroughly squelched. Men who thought it foolish to buy kerosene lamps sixty years ago because the oil fields of Pennsylvania 'would soon play out' are dead. We can keep 50,000,000 motor cars running a thousand years if we put all our resources to work on the problem."

Oil for 1,000 Years

Basing its estimates of future supply from the area now producing, on the fact that only a limited percentage—possibly as low as 20 percent—of the oil in the sands is recoverable by present methods of flowing and pumping, the Institute Committee calculates that 25,000,000,000 barrels 'can be recovered by improved and known processes, such as flooding with water, the introduction of air and gas pressure, and mining.' Production from known sources such as oil shale and distillates from coal and lignite will bring the future supplies of petroleum to a grand total of over 734,000,000,000 barrels, according to the report. This is enough oil to run the country at the present rate of consumption for approximately 1,000 years.

ESTABLISH COURSE IN ART OF LIVING

New Study Open to Juniors and Seniors at Connecticut College

A course in the art of living, open to juniors and seniors, has been inaugurated at Connecticut college, New London, Conn., in connection with the department of home economics. The purpose is to enlarge the student's knowledge of present-day conditions and affairs in order that, as a cultured woman, she may correlate her book knowledge and the skills acquired in college with the world of practical life that must be faced upon completion of her college career. The method employed is lecture and conference, and 12 instructors representing the major departments of the college curriculum co-operate in the course, in association with the president of the college, and a physician and a lawyer from the outside.

As introductory to the course, the philosophy of the essential unity of life is emphasized, followed by presentation of the principles of the sciences of geology, biology, chemistry, and physics. The social sciences, as embraced in the scope of home economics, including music, literature, and the fine arts, are then considered, and the course is rounded out by a resurveying of the bearing of the entire course upon the whole problem of morals, ethics, and religion. Much reading, with critical reports and essays on the topics covered, is required for the successful completion of the course. It carries six points credit.

LOVERS OF THE TRUTH

There are many more or less clever persons whose love of truth is so uncompromising that they cannot accept any religious creed, or annex themselves to any religious society; but the same love of truth that keeps them thus aloof does not always prevent them from misrepresenting tenets they cannot accept. One who knew little about human nature would suppose that those who are too scrupulous to believe in a certain form of religion would also be sufficiently scrupulous to obtain from misrepresentation. But I have observed the phenomenon so frequently that it has ceased to astonish.—William Lyon Phelps in the November Scribner's Magazine.
