They have accumulated their national wealth through production carried to such a point that they are turning out, with six per cent of the world's population, half the staples of world industry. What is more important, they have established a standard of wages and living, of reward for labor and productive enterprise, incomparably the highest in the world. They have achieved this through methods the rest of the world can emulate, if it will. The solution of the comparative poverty of the rest of the world is through adoption of our system of political unity, through abandonment of international hatreds, prejudices and rivalries largely of economic origin, through less politics and more production of the necessities of life. The solution is not in dragging America down to their level, but in rising

Not for the U. S. "The American people will not play this game. They will leave it to those who have begun it. They will not sacrifice American standards of life in order to make profitable American investments in the cheap labor markets of the Old World. They will not forgive the national debts of European countries to the United States in order to strengthen the European security for private debts to American investors. They will fight no wars to collect these debts either private or public. They will not create a condition in the United States at the behest of the internacommunists of capitalism which will compel Americans, because of the social upheaval sure to follow an attempt to degrade our living standards to those of Europe, to fight a civil war with proletarian com-
