SOCIAL PROBLEMS AND THEIR REMEDY

UNITED CHARITIES' WORK

Discussion of Conditions Facing This Organization Is Interesting; Cannot Be Ignored

Have you heard of the woman who said she disliked social workers, because just as soon as one social problem was settled they looked around until they found something else the matter.

Mrs. Florence Kelly, in an epoch-making speech at the National Social Workers conference, discussing mothers' pensions and provisions for widowed mothers.

Question of Responsibility - There remains the question of individual responsibility as to how far the difficulties are such as could have been avoided.

Before locating the responsibility for the causes of social maladjustments let's look at them, recognize them, see where they are, and how they are interrelated.

We may not know accurately about the population as a whole, but we have accurate data on 184 families recently studied by the United Charities of Chicago.

The major problems are distributed as follows: and out of 184 families in 107 instances they are the problem of the men, in 65 of the women, in 4 of the children, and in 8 they are shared by both parents.

In 184 families there were discovered and recorded 1500 instances of defects, either permanent or remediable.
