**HOPE TO GET STATE AID ON N. SHERIDAN**

which bridges were necessary on hard roads in the building of which state aid was given certain cities, and in those instances the state built the bridges on its own specifications. It is hoped that similar assistance may be obtained in the case of North Sheridan road, although there is no certainty of this as yet.

**Procedure Necessary**

The procedure in cases of this kind, the report explains, is for the local improvement board to proceed as for any similar improvement, and when plans and specifications are ready to apply to the state for aid. If plans and specifications are approved by the state highway engineers, and if state aid is granted, then the state pays the costs of the equivalent of an 18-foot pavement construction according to state specifications. The remainder of the cost, in such instance, to be paid by the municipality, or by special assessment.

**Property Owners to Meet**

It was moved to call an informal meeting of property owners affected on North Sheridan road to meet this Thursday evening at the city hall to talk over the problem with the board of local improvements, and letters have been sent out to these property owners inviting them to meet with the board at that time. It is explained that there is much to be done before anything definite can be stated regarding the project, but an effort will be made to secure state aid, if possible.

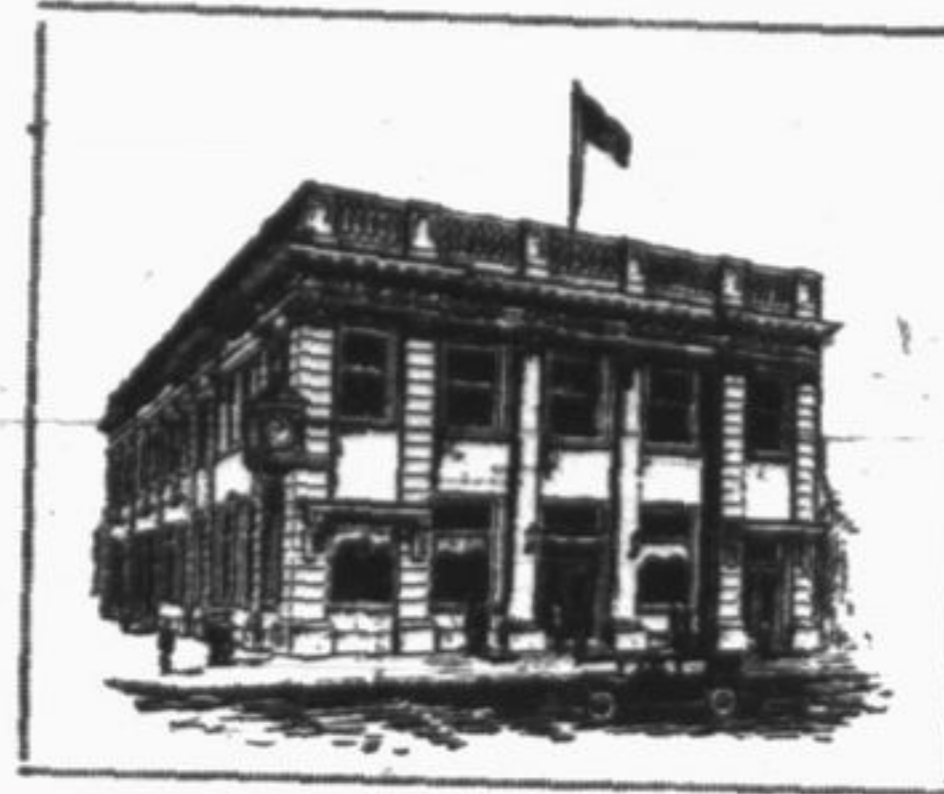
As has been explained before, under the state law, cities and towns of certain population in Cook county are given aid in building bridges, but this law does not apply to cities and towns in other counties, and hence the necessity of a special appropriation. Glencoe received state aid in building its bridges, because it is in Cook county, it is pointed out.

**Other Business**

At this meeting the petition of Hoyt King for the annexation of a small tract north of Deerfield avenue and west of Ridge road was laid on the table until next meeting.

Action on a plat of a part of the Kimball estate was withheld until it has been definitely ascertained if a street therein is 66 feet in width. The Nixon plat of a tract on Clavey and Ridge roads was approved, subject to signature and checking of the area. Permit was granted the Chicago & Northwestern railroad to put in parking space.

The returns of the city primary election were officially canvassed and no material change in the results was reported.
