A special 12-car train carrying 2,- adjudication. 618,400 "Baby Ruth candy bars, weighing 400,000 pounds, one of the largest single consignments of confectionery ever shipped will leave Chicago for California and the north Pacific coast over the Chicago and Northwestern, Union Pacific, Southern Pacific railways, Friday, March

If placed end to end, the confectionery would make a giant "Baby Ruth" candy bar over 165 miles long. The present shipment, an innovation in the candy business in the United States, is the fifth trainload movement of candy bars manufactured by the Curtiss Candy company of Chicago that has been made in the last several weeks, two already having been moved to Pacific coast points, one to New York City and one to southern points.

These five solid trainloads are the first of thirty-two trainload shipments that are being moved by this firm to all parts of the United States within a period of sixty days, comprising the largest movement of confectionery in history.
