

### HARD ROAD PROGRAM IN COUNTY IS HUGE

COST IS ABOUT \$3,480,000

Public Hearings Set for March 31 at Waukegan; Would Add 116 Miles of Pavement; Routes Affected

Preliminary steps that will probably give Lake county eventually 116 more miles of state paved roads at a cost of nearly three and one-half millions of dollars will be taken when public hearings are held March 31 at the Masonic temple in Waukegan by the state highway department, which has sent out notices of the hearings. Some of the roads which it is proposed to improve connect with Lake Forest, Highland Park and other points in this vicinity.

The hearing for March 31 include the following routes, 53, 57, 59, 59A, 60, 68, 172, 173, and 176. The hearing which would deal with the routing of the highways, will be the biggest ever staged in the county, it is predicted. Roads Affected

The routes are as follows: 53. Starting near Half Day and extending in a southerly and westerly direction to intersect with 111 street

and Archer avenue, Chicago. Paving in county three miles. 57. Beginning at the northern limits of Chicago in Tessville and extending

northerly into Highland Park. It is problematical if any of this road will be in Lake county as Highland Park limits run to the Cook county line. 59. Starting at route 69 south of Plainfield and running northerly into

Antioch, enters county at Barrington and serving reasonable communication for Wauconda, Antioch and Ingleside. Twenty-three miles in county. 59A. Beginning in Volo and run-

ning southeast to Lake Forest, serving Diamond Lake and Ivanhoe. Length 18 miles.

60. Starting north of Richmond to the Wisconsin line and extending south to Chicago running over 59 between Ingleside and Wauconda and serving Ingleside, Wauconda and Lake Zurich. This is a 22 mile stretch.

68. Beginning at a point two miles due west of Lake Bluff and extending north to the Wisconsin line. road would parallel the lake shore about two to four miles inland and be an outer belt to Lake Bluff, North Chicago, Waukegan, Beach, Zion and Winthrop Harbor. It is 15 miles long.

172. Beginning 1 1-2 miles north of Libertyville where route 21 leaves Milwaukee road and extending east to Grand avenue serving Libertyville and Gurnee. Length 5 miles.

173. Starting at Sheridan road at or near Zion and extending west on a parallel to the state line running into Rockford. This route is 20 miles long in the county and would serve
