### MILLS RESIDENCE DESTROYED BY FIRE

on fire in the Mills home. Mr. Mills and family were spending the evening with relatives and nobody was in the house when the fire started, it was reported.

#### Strenuous Battle

The alarm was received by the firemen at 10:44 p. m., and it was four o'clock the next morning before they were able to leave the scene. The flames, they state, had gained such headway up the walls and partitions in the house before they arrived as to

preclude possibility of saving the structure. Some of the contents, however, were removed from the first floor, including two fine oil paintings valued at about \$5,000 each by the owner, according to the firemen, two of whom, Hennig and Proctor, risked their lives on the fireweakened floor to salvage.

Fire apparatus from Highwood and Fort Sheridan was summoned, and the fire fighters from those stations were prompt to respond and gave valued assistance to the local department in their difficult task of conquering the flames in the Mills residence and protecting the adjoining houses. Fighting against tremendous odds caused by the long start which

the fire had obtained, the three fire companies did splendid work and deserve great credit for their efforts.

The Mills residence was one of Highland Park's old landmarks, having been erected more than 50 years ago and since remodeled.

#### Other Alarms

Several other fire alarms were answered by the department during the past week. On April 7 a roof fire at the residence of Carl Grant on Judson avenue was extinguished with damage resulting to the extent of about \$50, the firemen report.

On the same day the firemen were called to the J. Starrel home on South Sheridan road, where a child had accidentally locked himself in the

bathroom, and the nurse, fearing he might suffer injury, sent in an alarm. The firemen opened the door and released the child unharmed. A tree on fire in another part of town also resulted in another alarm last week.

#### Have Good Record

So far this month, Fire Chief Hoskin reports, the firemen have answered nine alarms, some of them long runs. Up to this week they have responded to 56 calls since the first of the year, a number as large as the entire annual total of fires only a few years ago. In five years, he reports, despite the large number of fires here, there have been only three instances in which fires have caused total losses of buildings and contents,

and this is regarded as an especially good record for a department in a city of this size and with the number of firemen and apparatus available.
