MONTHLY REPORT OF STATE TREASURER

The monthly report issued by State Treasurer Garrett D. Kinney showed that the interest earned on state funds during February totaled \$71,788.88 and for January amounted to \$72,328.27. Cash and moneys in state depositories on the last day of March totaled \$19,902,000 and deposited cash, inactive funds, active funds, cash in vault, coupons and federal funds totaled \$35,791,221.37. The total bonded-indebtedness of Illinois is \$137,212,500.
