Building Improvements Report for North Shore; General Slump is Seen

Chicago suburbs in May did approximately \$10,000,000 in building construction. This figure is based on building permits filed in 21 of the principal suburbs.

According to a special survey made by S. W. Straus & Co. of building in the Chicago area, these 21 suburbs filed plans for building amounting to \$9,687,121 last month, a loss of only 5 per cent against the building volume in the same suburbs last year.

The suburbs showing gains in May over April this year included Berwyn, Blue Island, Cicero, Highland Park, Lake Forest, La Grange and Waukegan.
