Russell Sard of the Columbia university, the greatest living authority on economic geography explains the idea in a reoviutionary interview:

"It is merely an accident of history," he says, "that agriculture started with annual plants-grasses, wheat, rice and corn-instead of with trees-date, olive, acorn and others. People can live just as well on acorns and walnuts and similar foods, as on the seeds of wild grasses. We need now a whole series of new crop trees, making food for men and his domestic animals, and at the same time holding and conserving the precious soils with their roots."
