OPPOSE RETURN TO RIMLESS GLASSES

Safety Engineers Declare They Are More Dangerous Than Other Kind

Safety engineers are reported to be somewhat disturbed by the suggestion that, for the sake of style, there is propaganda being carried on with a view to a return to the wearing of the antiquated rimless glasses. It is pointed out that the motorist whose glasses were blown off or dropped and broken, thereby depriving him of the aid to vision provided by glasses, would become almost as great a menace to himself and those in his car and to other drivers and pedestrians as a man under the influence of drink.

The style of wearing rimless glasses, with the great risk of breaking, would, it is asserted, be quite as dangerous as the style of carrying a hip flask and making the mistake of mixing hooch with gas.

All that has been accomplished in states where vision test is required to obtain a driver's license would be more than offset, it is claimed, by the general adoption of glasses without protection rims such as the "shell rims" which are so much in vogue. It has even been suggested that just as laws provide for proper headlights and other aids to safe driving, it should be made illegal for a motorist to wear glasses so susceptible to breakage as those of the rimless type.
