OLDEST MASON HEARS DISTANT GREETINGS

The oldest Mason in the United States and likewise the oldest naval officer in the country, celebrated his one hundredth birthday on March 22 at Hood River, Oregon.

In honor of the event, a special telephone hook-up was arranged between Philadelphia and Hood River so that, while the Hood River Masons were honoring Captain Charles Alexander Schetky, retired, of the United States Navy, the Masonic Lodge No. 2 of Philadelphia, the lodge which he joined seventy-two years ago, was able to send him its congratulations by word of mouth. The banquet in Philadelphia was held in the Masonic hall. It was the first time in many years that Captain Schetky had had the opportunity of talking with his brothers in Philadelphia, although he had traveled all over the world and has carried the good will of the Philadelphia Masons into virtually every work or rest without worry as to their welfare.

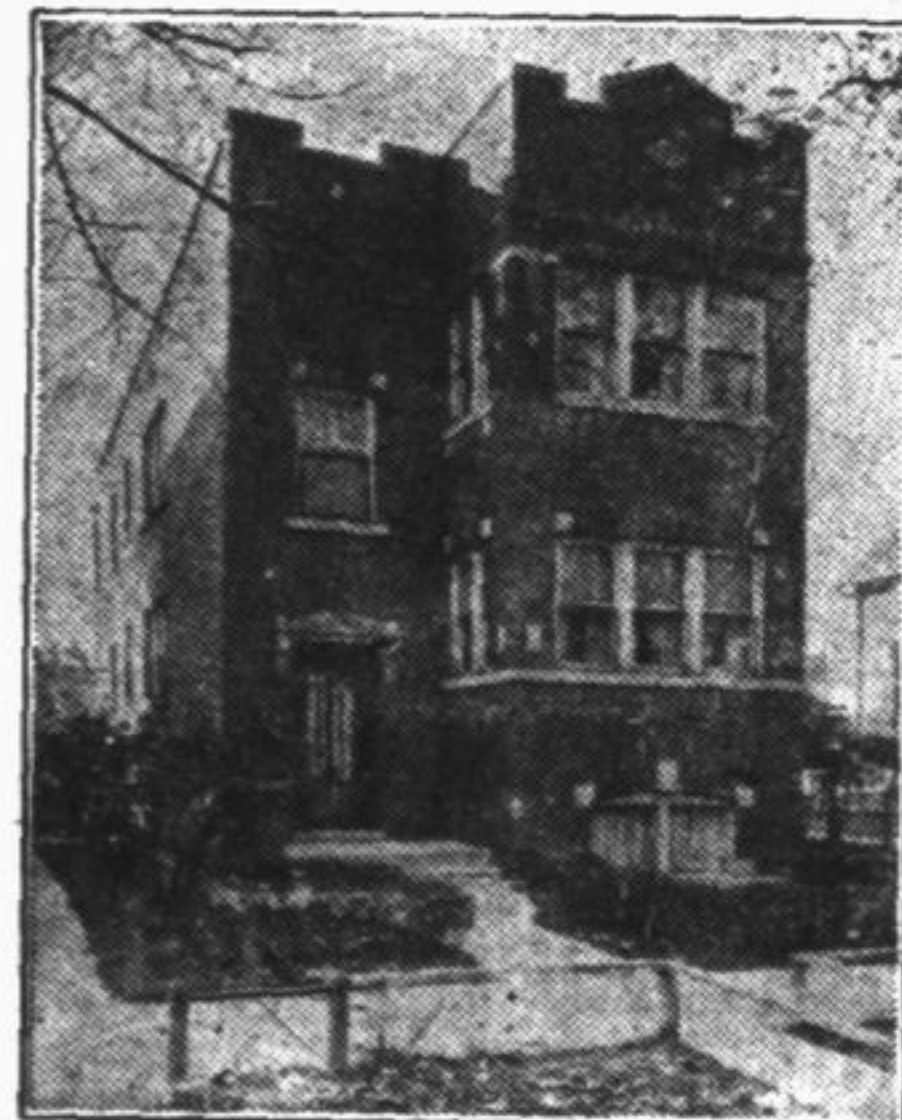

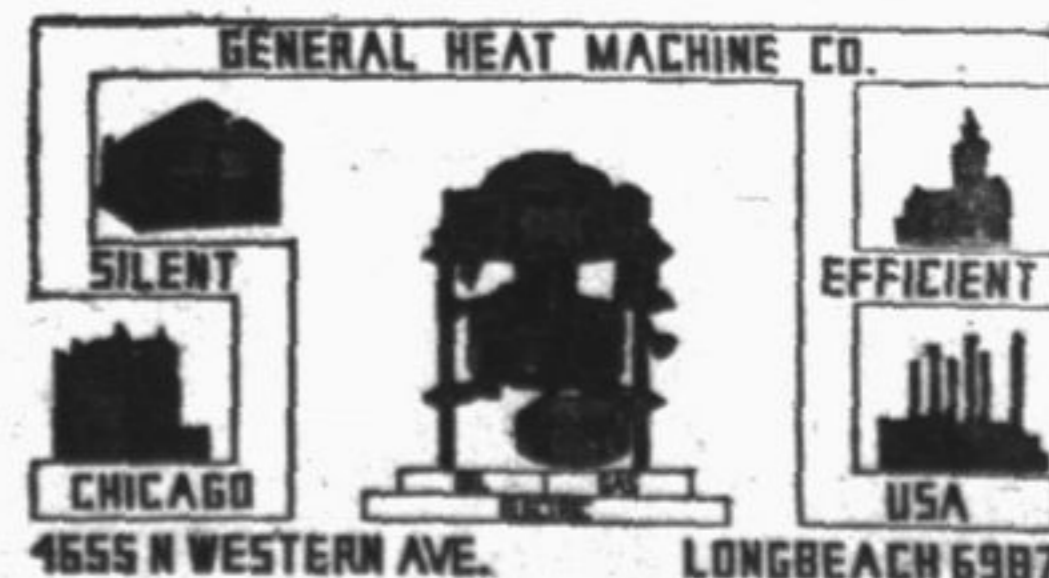
