"The bill was not filed by any individual tax payer, but the Chicago Motor club itself as a resident and tax payer of the state on the plea that the organization owns and operates a fleet of motor vehicles using gasoline as motor fuel. The bill for injunction states that A. C. Bollingger, director of the department of finance of the state, is about to expend portions of a \$50,000 appropriation for the printing of various forms in connection with the collection of the tax, and is about to expend other portions of this appropriation for the employment of clerical help and the purchase of office furnishings and supplies and in fact that some of the \$50,000 already has been spent.
