MICHIGAN NOW HAS NEW CRIMINAL CODE

SOME RADICAL CHANGES

Entirely New System of Criminal Procedure Is Instituted; Old Laws Are Scrapped

Michigan's new criminal code, said to be unique among those of the Union, will become a law on August 14, having passed both houses of the state legislature. It has been signed by Gov. Fred W. Green.

Indictment Made Simple

A respondent may waive trial by jury in case he desires, which has proved to be of value in Maryland. So far as possible, the laws of "Arrest" have been made so simple that police officers can easily familiarize themselves with them.

Judge May Make Comment

The purpose of the framers of the code was to so arrange it that the decisions of the trial judge and the verdict of the jury could only be reversed in case of breach of discretion. This removes from the consideration of the trial judge the apprehension of reversals and the resulting supposed damage to his record.

USE GAS FUEL IN BIG PRODUCE MARKET

After 18 months' trial, gas has been accepted as the ideal fuel to meet the unusual heating requirements of the world's largest and most modern produce market, located here.

Transplanted from their old homes on South Water street, near the Loop, Chicago's produce merchants built themselves modern establishments. Six hundred gas-heated steam radiators were installed as an experiment to ascertain if they would provide the easily-regulated, odorless, economical heat required in the produce business.

In 1902, Mr. Orner reminisced there were but three sections of land in the total area of Wilmette. At present it is composed of seven sections.
