Be Careful of Fire, Leave Camp Grounds Clean; Park Carefully; Others

With the touring and camping season at its height, Charles M. Hayes, president of the Chicago Motor club, makes a few timely suggestions to motorists.

Be careful of fire. A large percentage of the most costly forest fires can be traced directly to careless campers or smokers. When parking in forests or under trees, avoid spaces where dead branches or pine cones may fall and damage your car. Do not cover the hood of your car with canvas or other material until it has had a chance to cool. Otherwise it will sweat and ruin the finish. Tourists should leave a clean camp ground behind them, thereby reducing the restrictions being placed on camping by owners of private property. Scattered refuse and broken laws are poor monuments for the motorists and sportsmen to leave behind, observes Mr. Hayes.
