### FRUIT CROP SHORT IN ILLINOIS, REPORT

#### CHERRIES, BERRIES, ETC.

**All Said to Be Less Than Usual and Peaches Also Below Average, According to Statistics**

Thrifty housewives of Illinois who delight to start into the winter season with basement shelves well filled with products of the canner's art find small ray of hope in the forecasts of investigators for the Department of Agriculture working in the leading fruit raising sections of the state. Indications are there will not be an average fruit crop in Illinois in any line.

#### Berry Crop Failure

With the cherry crop less than half the usual yield, housewives pinned their hope of making up this shortage with a heavier canning of berries. However, the heavy rains in the early part of the season produced a mushy berry, unable to stand the withering heat which swept the state in the ripening season. As a result there was practically a failure of the strawberry, raspberry and blackberry crops. The same was true with dewberries, according to the reports from sections in which this crop is generally most prolific.

What berries reached the markets were high in price and usually poor in quality, with the result that housewives made little effort to can the usual supply for winter consumption.

#### Apple Crop Short

Investigators of the state Department of Agriculture, making a survey of the leading apple producing sections of the state report the 1927

yield will not exceed 40 per cent of the average, and in many sections of the state will even fall below this estimate.

Young orchards in the western section of the state — Calhoun, Adams, Hancock and adjoining counties—give promise of a light yield, with many sections reporting an absolute failure. Older orchards are also bearing light, particularly of the leading marketable varieties.

#### Peaches Below Average

Pessimism prevails with regards to the peach yield. July forecasts show the crop will not exceed 35 per cent of a crop, and will fall 7 per cent below the ten years average.

Federal reports indicate the Arkansas peach crop will approximate 1,500 cars during the present season, and in this will fall 1,000 cars short of last season. A short crop is also reported in North Carolina.
