WAR PICTURE STARS RICHARD BARTHELMES

"The Patent Leather Kid" Opened at Wood's Theater Sunday Evening

First National's "The Patent Leather Kid" starring Richard Barthelme, had its initial performance at Wood's Theater Sunday evening, Sept. 18. The picture, which has a war background, particularly showing the part the tank corps played in the World war, is based on Rupert

Hughes' story of the same title. Alfred Santell is the director and Al Rockett was in charge of the production.

Like all special pictures given the dignity of an engagement under the auspices of a legitimate loop theater, the management of Barthelme's latest adventure has gone to great pains to pump up the opening to the importance of a real event. The engagement, which is the first of a number of special presentations to be made in the principal cities, will open during the week of the Dempsey-

Based on Rupert Hughes' story of the same title, originally published in one of the popular national magazines, Hollywood has turned out what the producers describe as a true transcript of the American doughboy in action in France during the World war.

In making the picture, the director, Alfred Santell had the co-operation of officers and men and equipment stationed at Camp Lewis in the state of Washington. These war veterans both men and officers, lived over again

and staged for the camera some of the warfare that only now, after a gap of ten years, can be recorded without exaggeration as it actually happened in battle.
