as the installation is turned on, one former schedule. feels an agreeable sun-beam-like heat as on a fresh spring day, warming with water or steam pipes.

Impart Little Heat It occurred to Dr. Lulofs that the rays of the sun, coming from an almost incomprehensive distance, impart very little of their heat to the surrounding air. He also recognized the agreeable sensation, especially in coldish, early spring days, the direct sunbeam produces on the body. The combination of these two things resulted in his new device, costing only half of the electric footstool heating.

Old systems of heating churches have often been very unsatisfactory. Advance heating is necessary in most cases, and the hot air, mounting to stool heating, whereby the heat remains near the ground, the fresh air above giving sufficient ventilation, without creating a draft. The huge Protestant cathedral in Utrecht is provided with this device. This kind of installation is considered rather expensive, about \$2 per head, and the amount of electricity consumer is also greatly increased.

Heating Capacity

Dr. Lulofs informed the correspondent of The Christian Science Monitor that the installation in the new Jewish synagogue has a heating capacity of 29 kilowatts. When in full use, it costs only 116 Dutch cents per hour, the killowatt hour being 4 cents (100 Dutch cents equal American cents). 
