

URGES CONTINUANCE ON ILLITERACY WAR

STILL NECESSITY IN U. S.

Federal Education Commissioner Declares Plenty of Room for Work in This Line

America still needs to make war on illiteracy, according to John J. Tigert, United States Commissioner on Education...

"We have two pictures of our illiteracy—absolute illiteracy as revealed by the census each ten years, and illiteracy as revealed by the army test in 1917," says Mr. Tigert.

Considered Literate

"If a man can write his name in any language he is considered as literate in the census returns. The officials of the army tried to find out the men in the draft who were really able to read and write..."

From 1920 Census
From the 1920 census we find that there were 4,931,905 people over ten years of age in the United States who could not sign their names in any language...

The census returns each decade show that the relative number of people who cannot sign their names is growing smaller but that the actual number of individuals classed as illiterate is only slightly smaller than it was in 1870.

The 1930 census will again reveal the number of people in our various communities who are illiterates. Local, state, and national pride can more easily be appealed to now than

It can after the census is taken. Most people are willing and some are anxious to do something unselfishly for the good of their fellow men...

BETTER PROTECTION IN STATE CUTS FIRE LOSS

Report of Fire Marshal Shows Reduction of Five Millions in 1927

Better observance of fire protection laws of the state of Illinois during 1927 resulted in a reduction of losses during the year totaling approximately \$5,000,000...

Losses for the first eleven months of the year totaled \$19,535,610, compared to a loss for 1926 totalling \$25,568,006...

"We are gratified, of course, at the showing," said State Fire Marshal Legreid, "but we do not presume too much on this record for the year. I am working at this time on plans to co-ordinate the facilities of the department to the fullest possible extent."

"We expect to push with all of the vigor possible both the inspection and investigation work. Inspectors will be kept constantly on the trail of hazards and investigators will keep after the incendiaries..."

"Our campaign to safeguard school houses will be pushed. Many counties have been covered and we have made plans to cover the balance as quickly as possible..."

Section 1. There shall be, and there are hereby directed to be issued, twenty-two (22) Park Bonds of this District of the denomination of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) each, to be dated January 10, 1928, all bearing interest at the rate of five per cent (5%) per annum, payable semi-annually, such interest to be evidenced by interest notes or coupons attached to said bonds respectively. Said bonds shall mature in accordance with the following schedule:

21 and 22 \$1,000.00 July 10, 1933
Both principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable at The Highland Park State Bank, Highland Park, Illinois. Said bonds shall be signed by the President and Treasurer of the Board of Park Commissioners and countersigned by its Secretary with his seal of office affixed.
SECTION 2. Except as to number and date of maturity, said bonds and coupons shall be in substantially the following form:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That the Highland Park East Park District, in the County of Lake and State of Illinois, a park district legally organized and existing under the laws of the State of Illinois, acknowledges itself to owe, and for value received hereby promises to pay to the bearer One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) lawful money of the United States, the 10th day of July, 19--, with interest thereon from the date hereof at the rate of five per centum (5%) per annum, payable semi-annually on the 10th day of July and January in each year, on presentation and surrender of the annexed interest coupons as they severally become due. Both principal and interest of this bond are hereby made payable at The Highland Park State Bank, Highland Park, Illinois.
For the prompt payment of this bond, both principal and interest, at maturity and for the levy of sufficient taxes to pay the same, the full faith, credit and resources of said Park District are hereby irrevocably pledged. This bond is one of a series of bonds of like date and tenor as to date of maturity, issued for the purpose of providing funds for the payment of lands purchased for parks in and for said District under the authority of an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois entitled "An Act to provide for the organization of park districts and the transfer of submerged lands to them, providing for a navigable bodies of water." Approved June 24, 1926, and the several amendments thereof.
And it is hereby certified and recited that such conditions and things required to be done in order to set the same in force and effect of the Highland Park East Park District and in the issuing of this bond have been done, happened, and been performed in regular due and season as required by law; that a continuing direct annual tax has been levied upon all the taxable property in said The Highland Park East Park District for the purpose of providing funds for the payment of lands purchased for parks in and for said District under the authority of an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois entitled "An Act to provide for the organization of park districts and the transfer of submerged lands to them, providing for a navigable bodies of water." Approved June 24, 1926, and the several amendments thereof.
