But, one may say, "How does this truth free one from the beliefs of ses?" This is clearly illustrated by a rubber ball. Suppose a ball were to be held so tightly in a hand that it would be distorted until it hardly resembled a ball. Now, how could this be corrected? The answer simple: Release the fingers one by one until the ball resumes its true form.
