NUMBER OF BANKS IN ILLINOIS IS SHOWN

The March report of Oscar Nelson, Auditor of Public Accounts for the State of Illinois, for the Banking Department of his office shows 1,341 banks under his jurisdiction. Of this number 1,064 are outside of Cook county, 90 of which are in the city of Chicago. The total resources of these banks are approximately \$2,800,000,000. The resources of state banks are rapidly increasing, showing the marvelous growth of the state of Illinois, as bank statements more clearly reflect the condition of a commonwealth than any other index.

The department has been exerting its efforts in the last twelve months, particularly, toward the consolidation of smaller units in the banking field so that one strong institution might replace two weaker ones. This has been accomplished to a marked degree as in the year 1927 there were twenty such changes. Aside from the policy of consolidation for the purpose of cutting down overhead and rendering better service to the depositors, the Auditor's office has urged an increase of capital stock, strengthening of surplus, and building up of reserves so that any loss occurring might be readily disposed of without any impairment of the rights of the creditors. Illinois, like many other states, has passed through a heavy period of depression, but this condition has been corrected to a marked degree.
