

C. M. T. C. LISTS ARE STILL OPEN, REPORT

CAPT. DIEBLER EXPLAINS

Application For Summer Camps To Be Received For Two More Weeks, Local Man States; Details

For two more weeks, the list of applicants for the Citizens' Military Training camps remains open, Capt. Joseph B. Diebler announced today, although because of the large number of applicants already received, only a few of those who apply will be accepted.

Young men of high school age are eligible. The government pays all expenses of the camps, which open July 27 and continue for one month, including uniforms, equipment, transportation, medical service and expert coaching in all branches of athletics.

Fifty Camps Filled

The capacity for all the camps throughout the country has been reached two months before the date of training, and in the Sixth Corps area, whose camp is located at Fort Sheridan, the capacity is nearly filled.

The War department seeks to distribute the opportunity for training equally to all sections of the country and each of the Nine Corps areas is given its due quota for assignment to committees on the basis of population.

New Mess Halls

The new mess halls at Fort Sheridan are rapidly nearing completion and the whole new camp will be ready for the C. M. T. C. The young men at this camp have always had exceptional opportunity for sports of all kinds, and this year, arrangements will be even better than heretofore. Capt. Applegrand will supervise the training in baseball, football, volley ball, swimming, tennis, boxing, wrestling, fencing and all kinds of track work.

Plans are being made for a student orchestra, student band and for amateur dramatics as well as for the usual dances, lectures, moving pictures and other forms of evening entertainment.
