N. S. LINE RECEIVES FIVE NEW STEEL CARS

Finest of Passenger Coaches to Be Placed in Service; 10 More Coming

Five of the 15 new-steel passenger cars recently ordered by the Chicago North Shore and Milwaukee Railroad—the North Shore Line—have been delivered by the Pullman Car and Manufacturing Corporation. They will be placed in regular service between Chicago and Milwaukee as soon as test runs have been completed.

An additional five cars are scheduled for delivery within a week, and the balance of the order by the end of the month, according to North Shore Line officials. Two diners and one parlor-observation car, also recently ordered, are due to be delivered some time in August.

The new passenger cars all have motors and include the most modern devices known to the interurban electric railroad industry. One car is equipped with Hyatt roller bearings to test the riding comfort of cars thus equipped in high-speed service.

All the passenger cars are equipped with the new "easy chair" type seats, upholstered in grey Byzantine plush. The windows are four inches higher than on the regular standard car, giving increased visibility. There are two toilets and a smoking compartment and the main aisle of the main compartment are covered with rubber tiling. Thermostatically controlled electric and hot-water heat and emergency lighting are other modern devices installed for the comfort of passengers.
