Thursday night, Saint-Saens' immortal opera, "Samson and Delilah" will be presented with Mme. Julia Claussen as the Philistine seductress, while Giovanni Martinelli will be heard in the monumental role of Samson. Pulaski, and in intervening spots. A particularly pathetic tragedy in connection with the storm was the death of Annie Keller, teacher of the Centerville school, who was killed in protecting the pupils under her charge.
