FOUNDATION OF TOWER OF LONDON SINKING

FEAR DAMAGE TO WALLS

Engineers Taking Precautions to Prevent Disaster to Ancient Fortress Centuries Old; Details

Apprehension is felt concerning the historic Tower of London, one of the principal tourist attractions in London, because of the fact that the foundations of part of the structure has begun to sink, says an Interna-

tional News dispatch. The fact was announced in the annual report of the National Physical

Laboratory which states: "Periodic observations of the movements of the quay wall end of the Salt Tower throughout the year. The main displacements are in vertical direction, and indicate a small but measurable sinking of the foundations of the masonry.

Cracks Discovered "In June, the request of His Majesty's Office of Works, an examination was made of the west wall, in which several cracks had appeared. These cracks have been kept under observation since they were first noted, but have so far shown no

signs of extension."
