

### VARIED PROGRAM AT RAVINIA NEXT WEEK

Masked Ball," which ranks high among the favorites of Ravinia patrons, is to be given as a special performance on Monday night, July 23, taking the place of the orchestra concert which is usually scheduled for the second night of the week.

#### Second National Concert

The series of national concerts which was auspiciously inaugurated last Sunday afternoon with a program devoted to German music, will be continued and the second of these is to be given as "An Afternoon of French Music and French Composers" on Sunday afternoon, July 22. The program will be divided into two parts, the first being a concert by the Chicago Symphony orchestra, Eric DeLamarter conducting and having Alfred Wallenstein, cellist, as soloist. The second part of the program will mark the appearance of La Chorale Francaise de Chicago under the direction of Charles LaGorgue. Leon Rother, French basso of the Ravinia forces will sing "La Marseillaise" and the Chorale Francaise will present four ensemble groups, three of them in French and one in English. The Count de Ferry de Fontnouvelle, French Consul of Chicago, and Prof. Paul Hazard of the College de France, who is now lecturing at the University of Chicago, will attend.

The third of the afternoons of national music is announced by Mr. Eckstein for Sunday afternoon, July 29, at which time the program will be devoted to the works of the best known Italian composers. Eric De Lamarter will conduct the Chicago Symphony orchestra and Jacques Gordon, violinist, will be the soloist. Chevalier Dr. Antonio Ferme, Royal Counsellor Commissioner of Italy, will attend the concert and has been delegated to speak by L. Zannini, Royal Consul General of Italy.

#### "Martha" July 22

"Martha," Von Flotow's charming light opera, will be the Ravinia offering Sunday night, July 22. This work with its romantic story and its appealing music, which includes the famous Spinning Quartet and the aria M'Appari, is always a favorite, and it is doubly so at Ravinia because of the splendid cast available for its presentation. Miss Florence Macbeth will, as usual, have the title role, while opposite her as Lionel, Mario Chamlee will appear. This time Miss Gladys Swarthout will be heard as Nancy, while Virgilio Lazzari will be heard in his accustomed part of Plunkett. Vittorio Trevisan will be Sir Tristan with Louis D'An-

gelo as the sheriff. Louis Hasselmann will conduct.

A special performance of "The Masked Ball" one of Verdi's outstanding works, has been arranged for Monday-night, July 23, with the same cast which has made this dramatic opera one of the greatest of Ravinia offerings. Mme. Elisabeth Rothberg will again be heard as Amelia with Giovanni Martinelli as Richard and Giuseppe Danise as Reinhardt. Others in the cast are Miss Macbeth, Mme. Claussen, Virgilio Lazzari, George Cehanovsky, Louis D'Angelo and Giordano Paltrinieri. Gennaro Papi will conduct.

#### "Madame Butterfly"

Puccini's masterpiece, "Madame Butterfly," will be presented on Tuesday night, July 24, with Florence Easton in the title role, while on this occasion Mario Chamlee will be heard as Lieut. Pinkerton. This American tenor has won new laurels at Ravinia this season, and there is reason to know that he is ideally equipped to sing the role of the American naval officer in "Madame Butterfly."
