

### BREAKS TRADITION DOWN IN BUSINESS

DEPARTMENT COMMERCE

One of Greatest Benefits of This Bureau Has Been to Simplify Practices; Aids Advertising

The department of commerce, during the past eight years, has broken through the bondage of tradition in American business. Probably the most difficult task which it has faced has been its effort to assist business to rid itself of the restraint of hampering methods and wasteful practices.

It has taken real pioneering to launch a national movement to dis-a time-worn load that business has been carrying because it felt obligated to do so out of respect for its forefathers. The reports of the division of simplified practice shows the results that have already been achieved through sensible leadership in introducing standardization and various new methods consonant with the necessity of the times.

**Simplified Practice**  
This campaign for simplified business practices has entered the business life of the country at a time when advances are made, not by opening up new resources, but by intensifying human effort and intelligence, which requires the best leadership the country affords. That leadership has a definite and personal influence upon the specific working causes of prosperity. These causes, according to Mr. Hoover's latest report, include "the growing use of mechanical power and machinery, a larger scale of production, the conscious and concerted effort to eliminate wastes and reduce costs, the high scale of wages with consequent general high buying power, and the relative stability of prices, money, and credit."

**Boosts Advertising**  
On another subject closely akin to prosperity, the department of commerce speaks with equal authority. "The notion that advertising is an economic waste has long since been abandoned," declares its secretary. "It has a social use in advancing standards of living and an economic influence upon mass production. More directly it is an economical form of distribution. The steady increase in

volume of advertising in our newspapers is only one proof that it is such an economical form of distribution, for if it did not secure greater results at less expense, it would decrease, not increase."

### SCOTLAND YARD HAS THREE CATCHING PLAN

The days of the automobile bandit in England are numbered. By an ingenious device for barricading main roads, Scotland Yard, Britain's famous police headquarters, believes it has solved the problem of preventing these bandits from escaping after perpetrating holdups.

For almost a year, numerous experiments have been carried out by the "Yard" in a London garage. The most effective trap devised so far consists of two steel drums, filled with material to give them a weight of ten tons each, connected by a wire, says International News.

The drums are anchored by a spiral spring and when not in action the linking wire will be concealed in a slot in the roadway. As soon as an alarm is circulated the wire will be raised bonnet-high by a lever and the obstruction marked by red lamps.

Any automobilist attempting to rush the barrier would find himself attempting to proceed with a dead weight of 25 tons attached to his car—that is, the total weight of the two drums, plus resistance of the spiral springs, which can only be stretched to an extreme length of fifty yards.

Tests conducted by the authorities have satisfied them that the device is the most practical yet evolved.

### For Meatless Summer Meals

With the vegetable menu it is nice to serve one starchy dish such as baked cheese rice, hominy fritters or macaroni croquettes made with chopped cold macaroni, cheese and white sauce, molded into croquettes and fried crisp in butter or margarine. These "substantials" give body to the meatless meal and make it quite satisfying.

**Before Strawberries Leave**  
For a luscious pineapple and strawberry jam, use two level cups of each fruit, chopped fine; add seven level cups sugar and mix well. Stir over hot fire, boiling very hard one minute. Remove from fire and stir in a half cup liquid pectin. Skim, pour and seal.
