Harold Martin, colored, 21, and George Boone, colored, 20, who played a more or less minor part in the murder of Beck, and who pleaded guilty last week to charges of manslaughter, were sentenced Monday by Judge Edwards to serve indeterminate terms of from 1 to 14 years in the Pontiac reformatory.

Martin drove the car which conveyed Clark, Bregette and Brown to a point near the Beck home. He took Boone along with him. Neither Boone nor Martin went to the Beck house nor did they get any division of the loot taken. Martin told the court he had been hired to make the trip to Milburn. He said he knew one of his passengers was armed and that the purpose was robbery. Boone said he knew about the robbery plot but had no knowledge any of the men were armed until after they had started out from Chicago.
