Things to Cook

Roast Turkey with Swedish Stuffing 2 cups stale bread crumbs

1/2 cup English walnut meats

1/2 cup raisins, seeded and cut in

Salt, pepper and sage to taste. Mix all together and put in a cor ner of the pan near where the turkey

with a cloth, draw it, preserving the liver and gizzard, but be careful not to break the gall bag. Wash well, having a little soda dissolved in the water. Fill the body with oysters or Swedish stuffing. Sew up body and the neck. Bind the wings and legs snaggly to the body, and lay thin slices of bacon on the breast. Lay the turkey on the grating of your roaster, pour in a cup of water, then cover and bake brown two to three hours according to the size of the fowl. When nearly done remove the cover and wash with butter, then dredge with flour and set in oven to 27th brown. Dish the turkey on a heated platter and set in oven while you fix the gravy. Thicken the contents of the dripping pan with a tablespoon of browned flour, seasoned with salt 38-42p and pepper, add to finely chopped gib-Boil one minute then pour in gravy boal.

Cranberry Jelly

I quart or pound cranberries

I cup water

1 cups sugar

4 teaspoon salt. Wash the cranberries, place them and the water in a granite or aluminum pan or in a baking dish. Cover and bake in the oven at 250 degrees for 1 hour.

Press through a strainer, add the sugar and salt. (Do not cook the mixture after adding the sugar.) Then rinse out one large mold, or six or more individual molds with water and fill them with the mixture. Set aside in a cool place for several hours

If desired, the cranberries may be cooked over a flame instead of in the oven. When this is done, cook the cranberries and water at simmering temperature until the berries are soft. Then proceed as directed above.

Plum Pudding

Mix together one pound of currents or seedless raisins, one pound of seeded raisins, 1/2 pound of finely minced suet, half pound brown sugar. one-fourth pound of flour in which has been sifted 1 teaspoon baking powder, one-half teaspoon salt, onehalf teaspoon of allspice, same of eleves, rind of one lemon and three ounces mixed lemon and orange peel and citron. Mix well, then beat four eggs light and with your hands mix them in, adding enough fruit juice or milk to moisten the whole mixture. flavor is improved.

The pudding should be steamed for 40 8 or 9 hours. You may put it in buttered molds, with buttered paper over them, or you may put in buttered molds with buttered cloths tied over them and boil about five minutes.
