Plan New Compressor for Gas at Deerfield

Application was filed with Illinois Commerce Commission at Springfield last week by the North Shore Gas Company to issue \$442,000 first mortgage five per cent gold bonds. At the same time announcement was made by the company of a program to expend half a million dollars for extensions to service and plant equipment in Waukegan and along the north shore this year. These improvements and extensions will be paid for by the bonds which the company seeks permission to issue. One of the improvements contemplated is a second gas compressor at Deerfield. The company has no manufacturing plant at Deerfield but

maintains an enormous holder there. The compressor is used to provide pressure for supplying patrons in that part of the company's territory. The business at that point has grown to such an extent that a second compressor has been found to be necessary. The estimated cost of the new compressor is \$75,000.

Waukegan to Vote on Street Rail Franchise

Special election on a street railway franchise ordinance which provides for extensions to cost millions of dollars will be held in Waukegan on or about April 20 if the city council in meeting this afternoon succeeds in selecting the judges and clerks of

the election, designating the polling places and then in fixing the date. The franchise provides for the extension of the lines of both the street railway and the railroad lines of the North Shore from the main line of the railroad at a point between Keith and Greenwood avenues. An extension to the east will follow the right of way of the Public Service company transmission line to Sand street and then south on Sand street to Clayton street affording street railway and freight carrying service to the north flats. The other line will extend west to the west city limits where it eventually will connect with a line that will cross the county. The first project is to be completed in three years while the other in ten.
