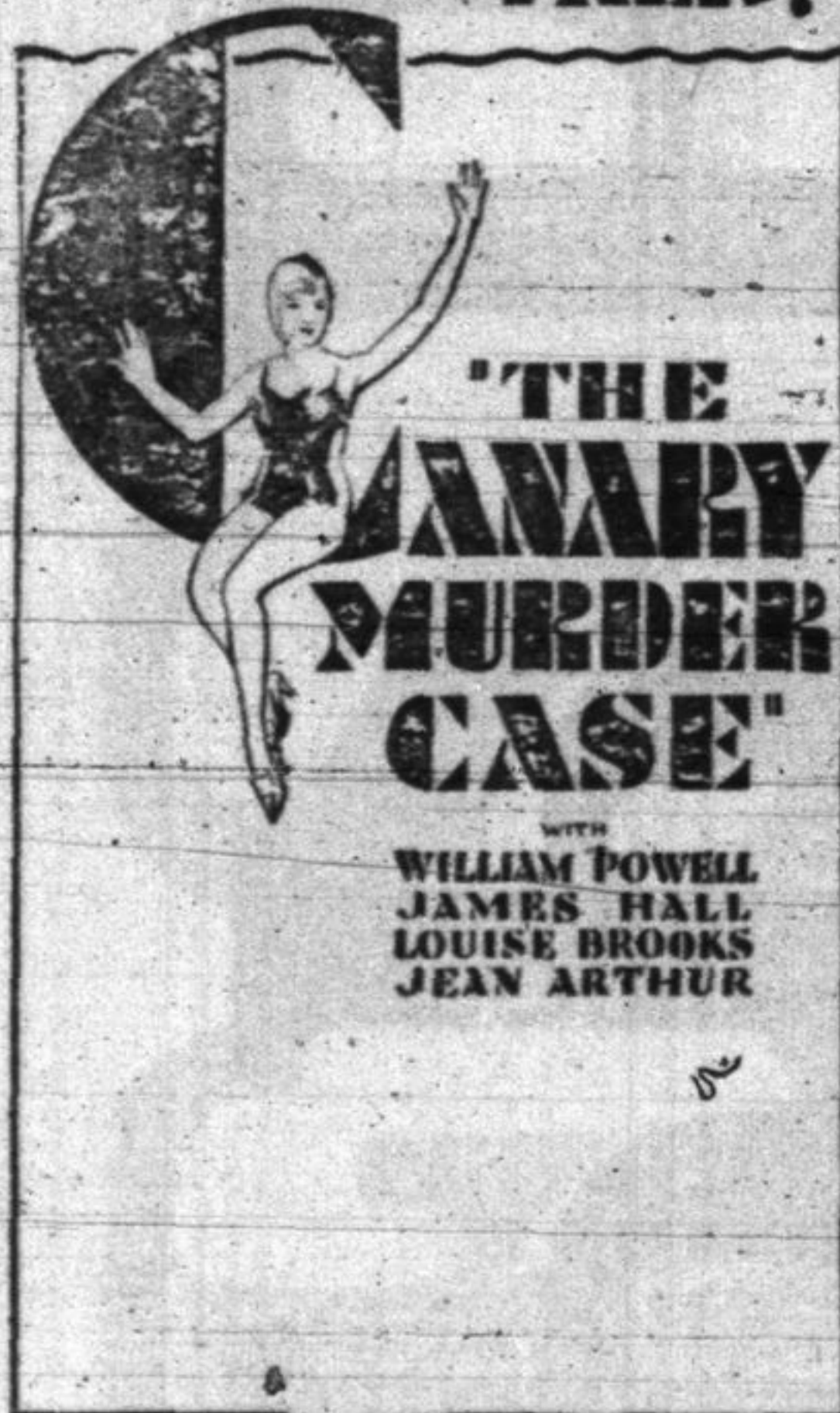

The Wages of Joy Is "Synthetic Sin"

An earnest ambition to obtain "experience" in the sinful life of New York's underworld provides the basis for the plot of "Synthetic Sin," Colleen Moore's latest laugh-picture, which will have its first local showing, will start Thursday, at the Genesee Theatre, Waukegan.

The humor and the drama of this Frederic and Fanny Hatton play, done for the "movies," are greatly enhanced by the synchronized music and sound effects, rendered by Nathaniel Shilkret's Victor Recording Orchestra.

Miss Moore, in the character of a

stage-struck girl, tries desperately to "see-life," having been told that she must gain such experience before she can hope to be a great actress. The chivalry of the gangsters and gunmen is roused by her obvious innocence, and his plans are thwarted in the most humorous manner.

"Synthetic Sin" was a successful Broadway stage play before Producer John McCormick decided to use it as a motion picture vehicle for Miss Moore, who was directed by William A.
