

**Enlist Deneen Aid  
in Zion-Broadcast  
Station Squabble**

Assistance of U. S. Senator Charles S. Deneen of Illinois is being enlisted by the city of Zion in its fight to be permitted to resume broadcasting at night, a privilege that has been denied since November 11 of last year when new allocations became effective.

A committee consistin of Secretary of State William Stratton, state Senator Ray Paddock of Wauconda, Representative Lee McDonough of Waukegan, Representative Richard Lyons of Mundelein, together with prominent Zion residents, held a conference with Senator Deneen at the Hamilton club, Chicago, Monday. At this session the senator was urged to use all possible influence to have the Zion broadcasting rights restored.

In addition to the mayor and other officials of Zion, the delegation from

that city included John D. Thomas, program director; and J. H. Depew, announcer of radio station WCBD.

Under the new allocations that became effective November 11, Zion was reduced from 345 meters to 238 meters and was prohibited from broadcasting at night. The city of Zion sent a delegation to Washington to intercede with the Federal Radio Commission. Following this hearing the commission made a decision in which they declined to change their original ruling. Zion then served notice of an appeal to the U. S. District Court of Appeals in the District of Columbia. It has been announced that the fight will be carried to the highest courts.
