Commissioner Reay moved that the engineers' final estimate in favor of Mackie-Thompson-Tamm, Inc., contractors, for division F, of the improvements and betterments to the

Highland Park Water Works in the amount of \$6686.60 by approved and voucher issued in payment of same. The motion prevailed.

Offers Resolution

Commissioner Zimmer moved that the following resolution be placed on file for public inspection for one week before its final adoption, approving the memorandum of contract between the city of Highland Park and Windes and Marsh for engineering services for the construction of a reinforced concrete pavement in Richfield avenue, Arbor avenue, Ferndale avenue, Edgewood avenue, Glenwood avenue, Eastwood avenue, Cloverdale avenue, Sunnyside avenue, Southland avenue, Midland avenue, Garland avenue, Northland avenue, Ellendale road, Ridgeland avenue, Deerfield avenue, and McCraren road, in the City of Highland Park; Lake county, Illinois, and the construction of a reinforced

concrete bridge in Deerfield avenue over the East Skokie drainage ditch, said improvement being more fully described and set forth in the ordinance initiating special assessment No. 333.

The mayor and clerk of the city of Highland Park directed by this resolution to enter into and execute and deliver in the name and on behalf of the city such a memorandum of contract as in this resolution described, under the seal of the city. The motion prevailed.

Commissioner Reay moved that the property owners' petition for the division of special assessments levied against lot 37, block 1, first addition to Ravinia Highlands for the construction of a connected system of water mains in South Green Bay road, etc., under Warrant No. 281; for the construction of a system of sidewalks in Ravinia Highlands and first addi-

tion to Ravinia Highlands under Warrant No. 296 and for paving a system of streets in Ravinia Highlands and first addition to Ravinia Highlands under Warrant No. 310, be accepted and that the corporation counsel be instructed to present said petition to the county court for approval. The motion prevailed.

Division of Assessment

Commissioner Brown moved that the property owners' petition for the division of special assessment levied against that part of the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of section 27, 43, 12 lying west of the Chicago & North Western Railway company right-of-way for the construction of a reinforced concrete pavement in Highland Park Gardens, etc., under Warrant No. 333, be accepted and that the corporation counsel be instructed to present said petition to the county court for approval. The motion prevailed.
