While, therefore, it is entirely proper that we pray to God in times of sickness and look to Him to heal us if it is His will and best. for us, we must not allow the body and its needs to crowd out of our minds the far greater needs of the

Let me repeat it: Sin is the root cause of all sickness, both of soul and of body. Our first concern must therefore be that our souls find healing from the sickening effects of sin. And such healing of souls is always connected with the forgiveness of our sins. If my sin has been the leprosy of lust, my forgiveness will be evidenced in a cleansing from that foul leprosy. If my sin has been alle blasphemous, cursing tongue, my forgiveness will be evidenced in a tongue that prays instead of curses. If my sin has been the rottenness of envy, my forgiveness will be evidenced in the soundness of love and unselfishness.

Whatever the sin, God's first benefit of forgiveness of the guilt of sin is always followed by His second benefit of healing the effects of sin. And whenever sin is the direct cause of bodily sickness, such bodily disorders are likewise healed once the underlying cause has been removed. "Bless the Lord, O my soul,
