Noted Chemist Dies at Home in Waukegan

Dr. Rudolph Breves, president of the Waukegan Chemical company, and long recognized as an outstanding chemist both in America and Germany and the originator of Brevoite lacquers, died at his home in Waukegan, Thursday afternoon of last week.

His death removes one of the most forceful and commanding figures from the industrial circles of Waukegan.

Many of the lacquer formulas in use today are the result of the vast amount of development work done by Dr. Breves, both in America and Germany. He was one of the widest known authorities in the field of lacquer manufacturing and application.
