More Cars in Illinois

Than U. S. Had in 1913;

Total Over 1,500,000

Illinois, with a registration of 1,504,339 motor cars, has 240,000 more automobiles than the entire United States owned back in 1913, according to a bulletin issued here by the American research foundation.

"Sixteen years ago the motor car registration of the United States totaled 1,258,062," says the bulletin. "At the beginning of 1929 the total for this country stood at 24,501,004.

"Four other states besides Illinois have more than 1,500,000 automobiles each. They are New York with 2,093,792, California with 1,727,024, Ohio with 1,662,000 and Pennsylvania with 1,642,866.

"Combined efforts of the automotive and oil industries in the United States have made possible the widespread ownership of motor cars in this country. By mass production and economic methods, the automotive industry has reduced the cost of cars in recent years and brought them within the financial reach of average American families. The big refiners of petroleum, such as Sinclair and Standard, have contributed inestimably to the increase in automobile ownership by directing their efforts not only toward developing cheaper processes for refining and distributing their products and in perfecting super-motor fuels, but in placing gasoline stations within easy distance of every American automobile owner."
