NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that bids will be received for the construction of a connected system of sanitary sewers, with necessary manholes, septic tank, in Ridge Road, Ridgelee Road, Old Briar Road, Balsam Road, Poplar Road, Blossom Court, and other streets, in the City of Highland Park, Lake County, Illinois, and the creation of a sewer district therein, as a whole in accordance with the ordinance therefor.

Said bids will be received by the Board of Local Improvements at its office in the City Hall, Highland Park, Illinois, until 7:45 p. m. on the 20th day of May, 1929, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read.

The specifications and blank proposals will be furnished at the office of the Board of Local Improvements in the City Hall of said City.

The Contractor will be paid in bonds, which bonds will draw interest at the rate of six (6) per cent per annum.

The successful bidder for the construction of said improvement will be required to enter into bond in a sum equal to one-third of the amount of his or their bid with sureties to be approved by the President of the Board of Local Improvements when entering into the contract for the construction of said improvement.

All proposals or bids must be accompanied by a certified check payable to the President of the Board of Local Improvements of the City of Highland Park for the sum of not less than ten (10) per cent of the aggregate of the proposal.

Said proposal must be delivered to the President of the Board of Local Improvements in open session of said Board at the time and place fixed herein for the opening of the same.

**Court Declares Man Missing Five Years "Dead"; from Gurnee**

James F. Strang, of Gurnee, who wandered away from his wife and year old daughter in 1905, last week was declared "dead" by Probate Judge Martin C. Decker so that his daughter, Mrs. Lila Wiatrowski, of Lincoln street, could share in an estate.

Her claim through her missing father lies in the Peter Strang estate located near Millburn.

In the petition the woman stated that her father, apparently in a jovial mood and happy with his home, suddenly disappeared and was next heard from through a postal card written from Jamestown, S. D. after that no trace of him could be found although efforts were made on several occasions.

Her mother, Mrs. Ruby Strang, later got a divorce on grounds of desertion and married again.

The extent that the daughter, who was an only child, will share in the estate is problematical, according to her counsel, Attorney Benjamin Parmelee.

**Senate Advances Bill Sponsored by Paddock**

The state senate recently advanced to third reading the order of passage, a bill sponsored by Senator Ray Paddock of Wauconda providing for uniform procedure in submitting maps of streets and alleys in new subdivisions. The county board is given the power, under the terms of the bill, to make reasonable requirements as to the laying out of streets, alleys, and public grounds in all subdivisions.

The bill has the endorsement of the Chicago Regional Planning association.
