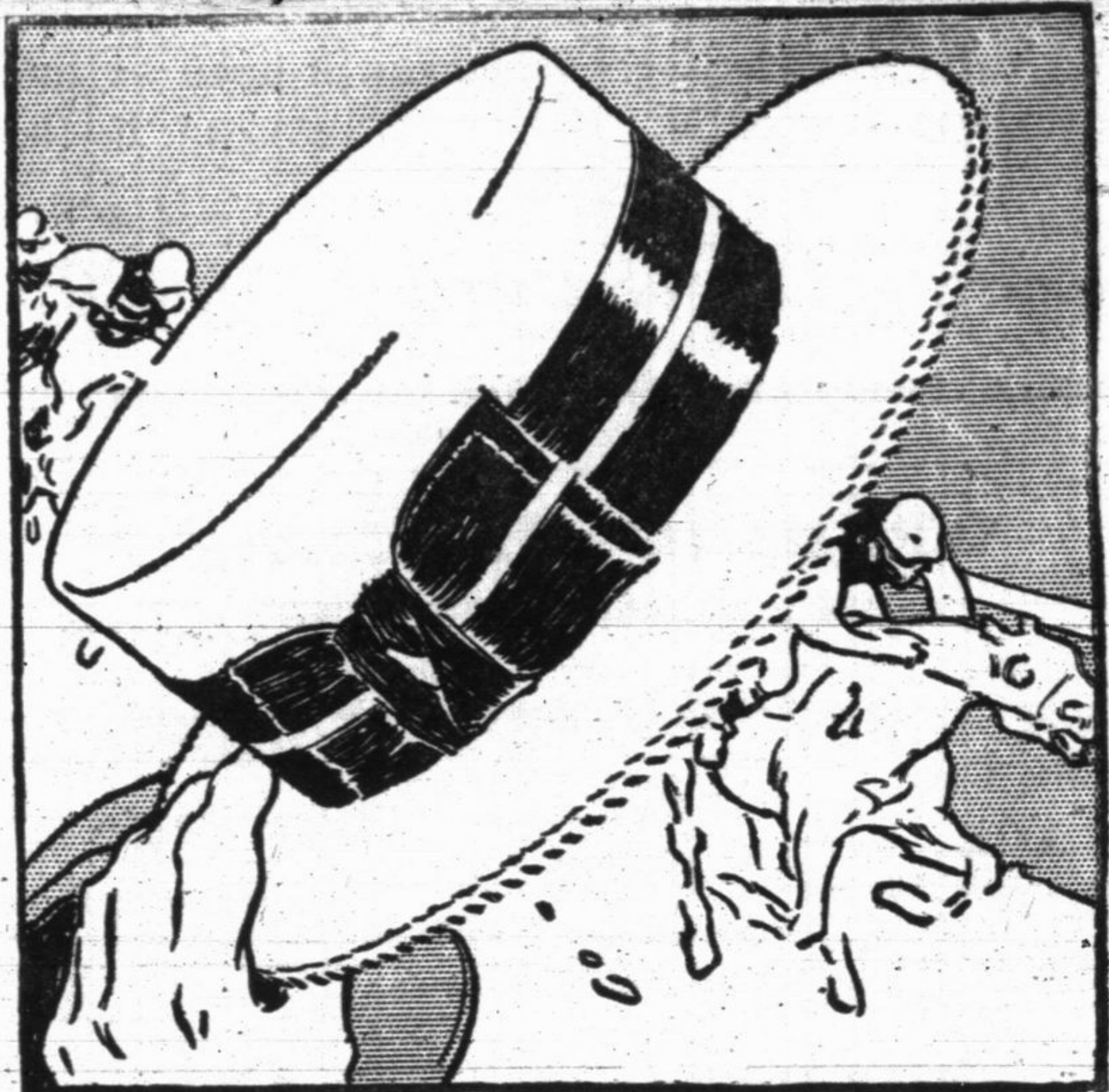

Graeme Players at Pearl Theatre Next Wednesday, Thursday

A record breaking crowd is expected at both performances of the Graeme Players latest and best comedy "Is Zat So" next Wednesday and Thursday at the Pearl theatre, Highland Park. The play is sponsored by the Dumaresq Spencer post of the American Legion. It will be the popular Graeme Players last appearance in Highland Park this season. Joe Driscoll who won many friends by his clever comedy characterizations at the Alcyon theatre last season plays an important comedy part in this famous play.

Unusual Plot

The two principal characters of "Is Zat So" are a prize fighter and his manager. From the moment the curtain rises until the final line these two converse in the jargon of the ringside to their own perfect under-

standing and the complete confusion of a family of elect New Yorkers into whose home they have been welcomed: Hap Hurley, the snappy manager is played by Joe Driscoll and the part of Chick, the dumb prize fighter, is played by Billy Frankenburg, remembered for his excellent work with the company last season. Hazel Dell Christy, Cecil Harman, Marjory Swip and Mary Edith Baumgartner assume the leading feminine roles. "The Trumpeter of Krakow" Winner of Newbery Prize

With intense interest every librarian in attendance at the annual meeting of the American Library association in the national capitol last week, awaited the announcement of the winner of the Newbery medal for the best juvenile book of the preceding year.

The awarding of this medal which was this year given to Professor Eric P. Kelly of Dartmouth college, for the Trumpeter of Krakow, has been an annual event since 1922.

The Trumpeter of Krakow is a tale of fifteenth century Poland. In the ancient city of Krakow stands a tower where every hour a trumpeter plays an ancient hymn. Joseph, the hero of the tale, acts for a time as trumpeter. His adventures in the city are many and all are connected in one way or another with a mysterious crystal of great value and beauty. According to the author's own story to Miss Hendee, the librarian, this tale was the result of Mr. Kelly's own experience in Poland where he found himself stationed for some time during the war, and from his passionate admiration for the Polish people and their nationalism grew this story.

The medal is appropriately named after John Newbery, London book seller who lived in 1713-67, and who first conceived the idea of publishing books expressly for children.

 - Smoky by Will James.
- The Highland Park Public Library will soon have on display an autographed copy of Mr. Kelly's book which may be read at the library, and other copies for circulation.
