For Sunday Breakfast

Sliced fresh pineapple
Fried rice Creamed chipped beef
Toast—Plum butter

Chicken Creole

Cook chicken until tender as for fricasse, remove liquor and keep hot over steam. Into the liquor put rice, shredded pimentos, small stuffed olives diced celery, diced Spanish onion and diced green pepper: cook until rice is fluffy and tender and arrange around chicken placed in center of platter.

A Novel Salad Dressing

Mix a cube of cream cheese with French dressing to bring it to a creamy consistency; add 1 tbl. chopped pickle and 1 tbl. of finely ground tongue. Serve over iced hearts of lettuce or a salad of hardcooked eggs on shredded lettuce.

You'll Like Carrots This Way

Cook 1 qt. carrots and use 2 cups carrot puree to ¼ cup bread crumbs. 2 eggs, ¼ milk, 1 ts. chopped parsley and seasoning. Mix carrots, crumbs and seasoning with beaten eggs add milk, blend and fill buttered pudding cups with the mixture. Set cups in pan of hot water and bake in moderate oven until firm. Unmold and serve with cream sauce.

New Great Lakes Head Arrives Late in June

Official information has been received at the Great Lakes Naval Training station indicating that Rear Admiral Walter S. Crosley, USN, has been selected as commandant of that station and of the Ninth Naval District, and that he will assume such duties shortly after June 29th, when he will be relieved of his present duty as commander of Tran Squadron One of the Fleet Base force.

Rear Admiral Crosley will succeed Rear Admiral Thomas T. Craven, USN, recently detached and assigned as the commander of the Yangtze patrol in China. Originally the Navy department designated Rear Admiral Yates Stirling, USN, as Rear Admiral Craven's successor, but later revoked his orders for this assignment.

Pending the arrival of Rear Admiral Crosley, Captain David W. Bagley, USN; is acting commandant at Great Lakes.
