

To Pave Sheridan Road Bridge in Waukegan at Once; Change of Route

Work of paving the surface of the Sheridan road bridge in Waukegan will be carried out early this year according to plans of the board of local improvements announced last week.

Paving of the surface of this bridge will close the last gap in paving of

Sheridan road between Chicago and Milwaukee and the city council is hopeful of having the work completed as early as possible this year.

Work of paving over the bridge has been delayed from year to year to permit the settlement of the earth in the approaches to the bridge. The city found it necessary to add to the fill several times.

Work will also be started this summer on the extension of Sheridan road through the old Y. W. C. A.

property which is to be made possible through the donation of the land to the city by Conzelman brothers, owners of the tract.

The extension will extend on an angle to Genesee street connecting with that thoroughfare near Liberty street. This will enable automobile traffic to pass onto Sheridan road from Genesee street without the necessity of turning onto Belvidere street. It will also eliminate one turn for automobiles.
