Lawson residence on Lone Tree point, one of the most picturesque spots on the lake. The club occupies a tract of 1,400 acres, with four miles of shore line and with miles of automobile drives and bridle paths winding in and out amoung the wooded hills. It was on this estate that its former master, Mr. Lawson, lavished millions of dollars and years of care. It has been acquired recently by a group of members.

ieties of birds have been observed there in a single season, and Lawsonia is in the path of the wild duck migration.

Every species of tree and shrub known to the north temperate zone will be found there. In addition to the 1,750,000 trees, one of America's most lavish display of lilacs is just now in full bloom. These are all French varieties, incuding such rare species as Mme. Perrier, Congo, Jules Le Blanc, Mme. Andre, and President Louvet.

Among the picturesque buildings on the grounds are the privatelyowned Anne Hathaway cottage and Glengary, a thatch-roofed lodge remodeled from an old stone barn; and the 75-year-old log cabin on the now grass-grown Green Bay-Marquette coach road, used as a summer residence by Charles E. Matthews of Oak Park.
