**Kenilworth Decides  
on Route of Through  
Highway in Village**

The village of Kenilworth has definitely decided to locate the proposed through highway immediately west of the railroad and along the railroad right-of-way, for which it is now acquiring titles and which it expects to accomplish this summer.

This announcement was made to the Winnetka Village council last week by Roland D. Whitman, who called the attention of that body to the importance of beginning at an early date to prepare for the completion of Winnetka's portion of the highway south of the Center street paving at Winnetka avenue with the north end of the Kenilworth pavement.

In bending the Center street pavement east, to connect with the Kenilworth pavement, Mr. Whitman said it will be necessary to deal with something like thirty property owners. Sidewalks will have to be changed, mains re-located, etc., and some time will be required to have all this brought about in order to proceed with the building of the remainder of Winnetka's portion of the highway, south of Winnetka avenue, action on which has been held up pending decision of Kenilworth on the location of the road through that village.

**Carpenters Vote Wage  
Increase of 50 Cents;  
to Get \$12.50 a Day**

Lake county carpenters together with those of Cook and DuPage counties, have ratified a wage increase agreement between the Carpenters' district council, with a membership of 32,000, and the Builders' Association of Chicago. The vote on the agreement was three to one in favor of it.

The agreement runs for two years and provides for an increase in wages of 50 cents a day, making the scale for carpenters \$12.50 a day. The carpenters asked for a five-day week, but the employers refused to consider this proposition.

It was agreed, however, that in the event a majority of the other building trades obtained the five-day week the carpenters will get it also.

The agreement is effective from June 1 and provides for the closed shop. It is based on the standard form of agreement for all of the trades, with arbitration of disputes on the job, and concedes to the union the right to strike if non-union men in any trade are employed by any member of the association.

**Marshall Reappointed  
Glencoe City Attorney**

Alexander H. Marshall has been re-appointed village attorney of Glencoe for another year, this action being taken at the meeting of the Village board last Thursday evening. Mr. Marshall is now entering upon his third term, the date of his first appointment being in April, 1927.

He is also a member of the Glencoe Zoning commission, the Glencoe Zoning board of appeals and a member of the Glencoe Playgrounds committee which acts as a board of directors of the Glencoe Golf club.
